

Prerequisite for Master Degrees

Beginning with the fall semester 2006, all students applying for entrance to the M.A. degree programs in Theological Studies at Notre Dame Seminary will be required to have adequate background to begin the study of theology. This requirement can be fulfilled through one of the means listed below; while enrolled in the philosophy course, new students can also register in a theology course.

1. Successful completion of a non-credit philosophy course during the first semester covering the following topics:
 - ❑ Epistemology
 - ❑ Ethics
 - ❑ Metaphysic
 - ❑ Philosophy of Person
 - ❑ Philosophy of God

(This course may possibly be offered during a summer session at Notre Dame Seminary or be taken at another educational institution)
2. Undergraduate background in philosophy and/or theology as determined by the Director of the M.A. programs.
3. Successful completion of philosophy online course/s that include the topics listed above and accepted by the Director of the M.A. programs.
